- **Who?** Our AGM is open to everyone. It will be attended by trustees, WRC staff & volunteers, WRC Members, and colleagues from across the refugee sector.

What is an AGM & What will it involve?

An AGM OR Annual General Meeting is a yearly meeting of the key stakeholders of an organization. Our AGM this year will focus on **the impact of widening dispersal.**

The afternoon will include speeches from our Chair of Trustees Harry Iles as well as our CEO Andrea Cleaver. We will also hear speeches from a Red Cross VOICES Ambassador as well as a WRC Volunteer. Attendees will also be invited to participate in an interactive discussion to share their thoughts on the widening of dispersal areas.

Where is the AGM?

Our AGM will be hosted at <u>sbarc|spark, Maindy Road, Cardiff CF24 4HQ.</u> WRC Staff and Volunteers will be present to welcome attendees to the building.

When should I arrive?
