Role Description

Community Changemaker

Changemakers will play a vital role in educating their communities and helping individuals understand their rights regarding housing in Wales.

You will be able to work with decision makers and share not only your lived experiences but also share the experiences of the various community groups you will engage with. To share your story in your own words is one of the most powerful tools to enact change!



Type of role:

Voluntary. Being a changemaker is a role specialising in housing challenges. We envision attracting a person who has a passion for communities.



Remuneration:


This is an unpaid role but that doesn't mean you don't get anything out of it. Changemakers will have their travel costs covered and receive railcards to help make exploring Wales more accessible!

Location:

Changemakers can be based anywhere in Wales. You will occasionally have to travel to our Cardiff office for meetings. Changemakers will co-deliver housing forums in different locations across Wales so this means a chance to travel.

What does a Changemaker do?

- Advocate and work with the many sanctuary seeking and refugee communities across Wales.
- Use expert lived experience to provide valuable insights into housing rights, housing options, and realistic expectations within the Welsh system.
- Share expert lived experiences and knowledge of communities to help respond to sector developments, Welsh Government consultations and champion co-produced solutions for legislation in Wales.



- Raise awareness and combat misinformation regarding housing options, helping sanctuary seekers and refugees understand their rights and the Welsh housing system.
- Co-deliver engaging webinars to housing association, local authorities, companies, and charities on the barriers facing refugees in accessing housing.
- Support the delivery of housing forums with the Housing and Policy Lead within community groups.
 - Co-produce accessible and inclusive community resources.



Who we're looking for

Essential Criteria

- Lived experience as a sanctuary seeker or refugee.
- A desire to give back to your community by helping others navigate housing systems and their rights.
- Willingness to gain experience, in community outreach, engagement, or education.
- Passionate about raising awareness of challenges faced by sanctuary seekers and refugees in Wales and promoting knowledge building within communities.
- Empathetic, with a deep understanding of the challenges refugees face.

Essential Criteria

- Ability to build trust and build rapport within diverse communities.
- A passion for championing all sanctuary seekers and refugees, regardless of their background.
- The ability to work both independently and as part of a team.
- Fluency in a community language (For example; Arabic, Farsi, Kurdish, Pashto, Spanish, French, Ukrainian).

Desirable Criteria

- An interest in, or knowledge of housing issues impacting sanctuary seekers and refugees.
- Having experience or being comfortable with public speaking.

As a Changemaker you will be attending housing forums and events in different parts of Wales. This is a great way to explore your new home, learn about different Welsh communities, and find your new favourite spots. If you are attending housing forums or any events as a Changemaker, the WRC will cover the cost of your travel for the event. Better yet, we will provide all Changemakers with a railcard (if you are of qualifying age) which will give you a lot more freedom to travel anytime!

This is also a unique opportunity to build a network spanning diverse community groups, charities, and WRC partners which is essential in finding future work.
